

Dear Members,

I write on behalf of your Board of Directors and Management Team. We hope you and your loved ones are safe, healthy and are coping with the current stay at home orders as best you can. Like you, we look forward to more freedom of movement in the coming months.

Whilst Sporties has been closed, your Board and Management have been very busy working to ensure your Club is ready to welcome you back when we can reopen.

During lockdown we have continued supporting our community with our team calling Members to check on their welfare and provide important social contact. This in addition to our free online raffles.

Our goal throughout this journey has been supporting our Members and Community to operate as a safe and trusted social hub. As you may know, our car park is currently being used as a Covid-19 testing site. What you might not know is we also offered our venue to the NSW Government as a potential Vaccination Centre should it have been required. At this time the Government has declined our offer, but we remain ready to assist if called upon, just like we did during the recent bushfires.

When we do re-open, we will of course, first and foremost, comply with whatever laws and conditions the NSW Government imposes. Our Premier has clearly indicated that certain freedoms will be granted in the days ahead, to people who are vaccinated. This aligns with the views of your Board and in particular the Board's legal obligation to provide a safe venue for all Staff, Members and Guests.


To this end, your Board intends to mandate that on re-opening, all Members, Guests, Visitors, Staff, Management and Contractors will need to have received both doses of a Covid-19 vaccine and show their Covid-19 certificate before entering the Club. Of course, if a person cannot have a Covid-19 vaccine due to a medical contraindication, and has a certificate, in the form approved by the NSW Government Chief Health Officer, from a medical practitioner, that specifies the medical contraindication, they will not be required to comply with this decision.

We hope you understand, in taking this position we are striving to make Sporties safe for everyone and give you confidence when you visit Sporties that you are in a vaccinated environment and as protected as possible from Covid-19.

To prepare for when Sporties re-opens, we call on you to *'get the jab'*, so we can welcome you back.

Be assured we will keep you updated in the weeks ahead as developments arise, but until then, to you and your family, please stay safe and well.
